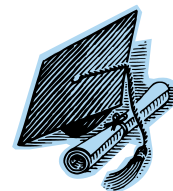

# Development News

## Financial Update – August 2017 through March 2018

- The current budget has a projected income for this fiscal year of \$1,874,949. The projected expenses for this fiscal year is \$1,851,961.
- The projected income includes a total of \$748,578 in Development/Fundraising income. This income is generated from the following resources:
  - + Memorials
  - + Thrivent Choice Dollars
  - + Trinity Resale Shop
  - + Tickets for Textbooks
  - + Built on Firm Foundation Donations
  - + The Trinity Auction
  - + Trinity Tuition Assistance
  - + The Lutheran SGO Program
  - + Special Gifts/Donations
- Development/Fundraising income from 8/1/17 to 3/31/18 is \$585,278.
- Last year the Trinity Resale Shop provided a generous donation of \$92,000 to Trinity in July.

## The Lutheran SGO Program!

Trinity has received over \$225,000 in total SGO gifts for tuition assistance during this fiscal year. This is an increase of over 150% from last year.

Trinity had 72 donors contribute to the SGO program in the name of Trinity this fiscal year. This is an increase of over 224% from the last fiscal year.
