This team used selling short techniques with some failures but prevailed through the game.

The second place finish in the Southeastern Division was Abby Hackman, Trent Shoemaker, and Jake VonDielingen with \$115,983.61. This team invested early in losing stocks but came from behind to place second.

The third place finish in the Southeastern Division was Piper Acton, Maddie Bell, and Jodi Goecker with \$110,939.30. This team invested early in growing stocks and added other stocks during the game.

There were 2,312 state teams for the fall semester.

Lutheran SGO Program!



The 2017 Lutheran SGO campaign is finished and God has once again lavished us with His grace and provided for our school, our students, and our families through this outstanding program! Here's a quick glimpse of what was done through the SGO program this year:

In 2017 we received over \$215,000 in total gifts for tuition assistance. This is an increase of over 148% from 2016.

In 2017 we had 68 donors contribute to the SGO program in the name of Trinity. This is an increase of over 220% from 2016.
